JUDGES



Judges are recruited annually from ANREP membership in all regions of the United States and evaluation of all materials is completed online.

A minimum of two judges will independently judge each submission.

Judges' scores are averaged for all categories.

The call for judges will begin in December 2022 and ends on February 3rd, 2023.

Judges will have from March 3rd to March 19th, 2023 to complete their score sheets.

Your task will consist of reviewing 1-2 awards categories, and 4-8 award nominations generally over two-three weeks in March.

Eligibility

- Nominator and nominee(s)
 - must be active, paid members for 2023
 - Self-nominations are welcome in most categories
- Exceptions for teams
 - at least one ANREP member on team

Educational materials and programs must focus on natural resources and/or natural systems (e.g., forest, wildlife, fisheries, water, range, watersheds, climate, human dimensions, recreation resources, etc.).

Materials must be original works produced for use in an Extension program, although this requirement does not preclude their use by other organizations.



Eligibility

For judging in 2023, materials and programs must have been produced or received by the intended audience during January 1 to December 31, 2022.

If not selected for an ANREP award during 2023, nominations for Achievement Awards may be resubmitted in succeeding years.

Outstanding Educational Materials nominations may be entered in only one year and cannot be resubmitted unless significant changes have been made to the original product(s).

Educational materials may be entered in more than one class if they meet class criteria.



AWARD DESCRIPTIONS AND CRITERIA

Two major award categories:

- ❖ Outstanding Educational Materials Awards
- ❖ Achievement Awards.



Outstanding Educational Materials Awards

Purpose is to recognize outstanding Extension natural resource related educational materials

Judging will primarily focus on:

1. Is the nominated material exemplary and worthy of national recognition?
2. Content (40 Points)
3. Editing (20 Points)
4. Graphics and design (20 Points)
5. Evaluation and Impact (20 Points)

From a judge's perspective....

- Judges must stick to the criteria
 - Be sure to include information relevant to each criteria
- Have a colleague read your nomination before submission
 - Be sure nomination is clearly written
 - Judges know nothing about your program
 - Be clear
- Evaluation and impact statements are very important (and often omitted)
